## CURRICULUM

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Born in Panamà, 1953. Jewish Austrian-German parents who migrated from Europe to Panama in 1939.

**Comments on Style:** Zelenka started painting at age 7 and his works from those days till today, show a unique singular signature.

There is an important influence of what could be referred to as a Latin American Surrealism.

During the last 30 years and evidenced specially in works dated 2019/2022, one can find in his works, emphasis in the search to create a unique language, where art meets and deals with socio-political-philosophical issues in an original manner, palette of colors, media and techniques, (painting, sculpture and instalations).
